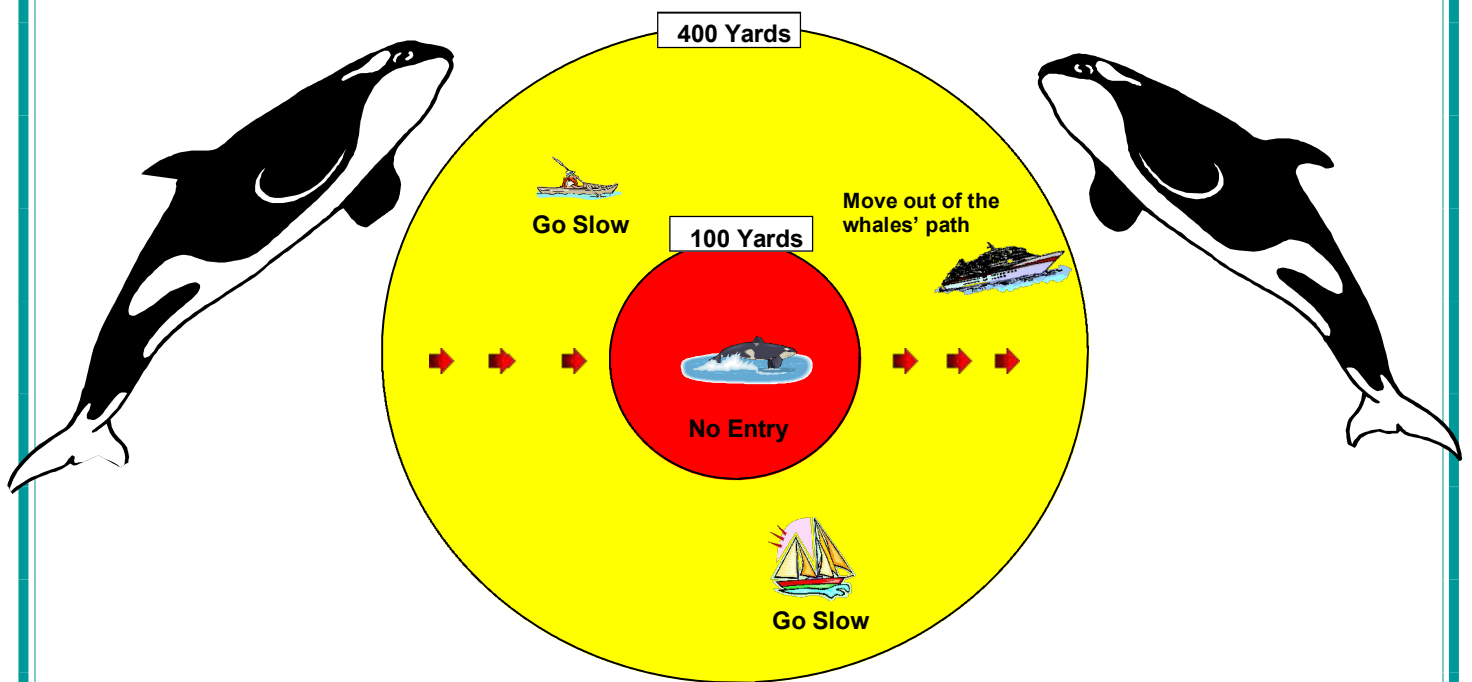




Give whales room to breathe (It's the law)

In San Juan County's waters: (SJC Ordinance 35-2005)

- Boaters and kayakers must not approach within 100 yards of killer whales.
- Move out of the way if whales approach your position.
- Disengage the transmission immediately if whales unexpectedly surface within 100 yards of your boat.
- Operate at a slow, safe speed when within 400 yards of any killer whale.
- Do not feed killer whales.



The southern resident killer whale, the symbol of the San Juan Islands, is an endangered species. When you encounter these magnificent animals, please show them the consideration and respect they deserve.
