

GET OFF MY TAIL! It's the law.

In Washington State, it is **UNLAWFUL** to*:

APPROACH within 100 yards of a killer whale.

INTERCEPT a killer whale by placing a vessel or other object to remain in the path and within 100 yards of a killer whale.

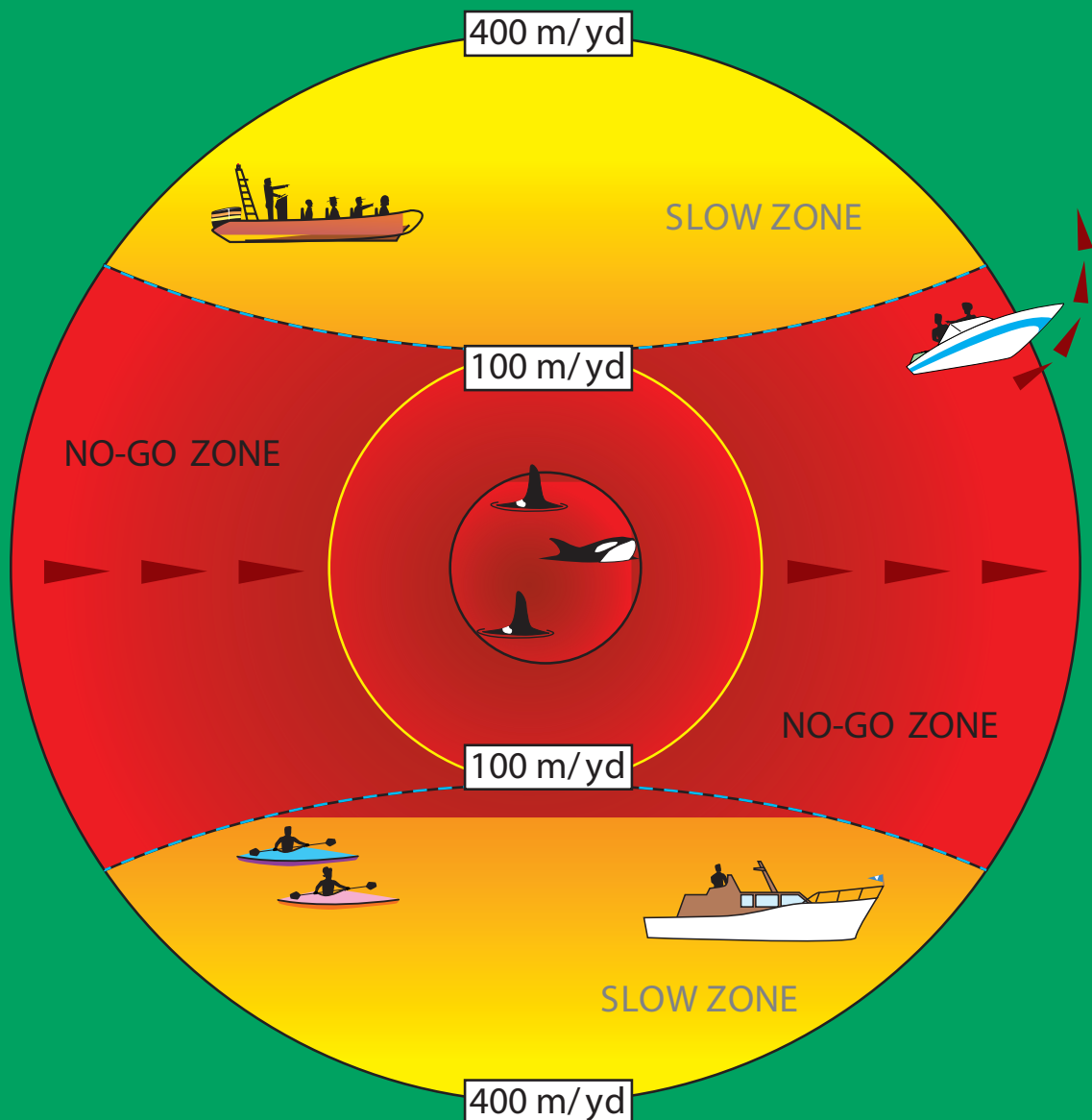
FAIL to immediately **DISENGAGE** a vessel's transmission within 100 yards of a killer whale.

HARASS any marine mammal.

*Some exemptions apply.
